OVERVIEW

The MomentumEI application programming interface (API) enables a user computer to automatically fetch data from the MomentumEI.com database. MEI also provides an RSS feed as an alternative technology.

Since the user does not logon, a different security model is used for both the API and RSS interfaces. Each user has a unique API key that is used as part of the URL. In addition, the special “DataDownload” permission must be granted to the user.

Your API key is shown on the Manage Profile page (click your logged-in username in main menu):

API Key

You have the "DataDownload" permission so you can use the API, RSS feed, and on the Search page you can use the "Download as CSV" feature.

To use the API or RSS feed you must specify your personal API Key (please do not share!):

JQJPM
/EU3PBJ

Note: the API Key will change if you change your password.



API

API functions are used for machine-to-machine data downloads. All API functions require an API key which is unique for each login user. Your API key is displayed on your Manage Profile screen if you have the required *DataDownload* permission.

1. AllTarEvents

Get all TAR events (any status).

[your-API-key] parameter = (see your profile page).

[format] parameter = JSON (default), XML, or CSV.

2. TarEventsChangedSinceLastRequest

Get all TAR events updated or created after your last access date.

Set your last access date by calling one of the Tar event APIs:

'AllTarEvents', 'CurrentTarEvents', or 'RecentlyChangedTarEvents'.

[format] parameter = JSON (default), XML, or CSV.

3. CurrentTarEvents

Get TAR events with status “Ongoing”.

[your-API-key] parameter = (see your profile page).

[format] parameter = JSON (default), XML, or CSV.

4. FutureTarEvents

Get TAR events with status “Future”.

5. RecentlyChangedTarEvents

Get TAR events updated in past X days.

[your-API-key] parameter = (see your profile page).

[days] parameter default = 7.

[format] parameter = JSON (default), XML, or CSV.

6. **SearchEvents**

Advanced Search for events using specified filters.

1. RangeBegin

Default if not specified: None, results are not filtered by Start Dates after...

Example: baseUrl?[somefilterparm=someval]&rangeBegin=1/2/2024

2. RangeEnd

Default if not specified: None, results are not filtered by Start Dates prior to...

Example: baseUrl?[somefilterparm=someval]&rangeEnd=2/3/2025

3. RegionCodes

Default if not specified: ALL, results are not filtered by Region Code.
